



## Charging for School Activities

### **Fees**

As Kings School is an Independent fee paying school the parents/carers are responsible for paying for their child/children's education.

The termly fees provide tuition, text books, work books and classroom equipment and materials. It also enables pupils to have swimming, short tennis, dance, French, games, specialist music and maths when timetabled for specific year bands.

Lunches are compulsory for FS1, FS", Reception and year 1, (from September 2014).

Fees are reviewed annually by Cognita.

### **Aftercare**

Is charged for in half hourly blocks. It is billed monthly in arrears. the hourly rate is reviewed annually.

### **Holiday Care**

Charges are made either on an hourly basis or a daily basis which ever is the lowest. The charges are reviewed annually.

NB The cost of meals is an additional charge in all the above cases.

### **Extra Curricular Activities**

At present we offer speech, piano, singing, drama, street jazz, early bird gym, ballet, football, martial arts, guitar and fencing.

A charge is made for these.

### **School Trips/Visits**

This incurs an additional cost to fees. The cost is based on entrance charges and transport.

This also relates to school journeys e.g. Skern Lodge, Heatree. School journeys may necessitate the provision of supply cover which may be accounted for in calculating cost.

Cost for visits into school by Theatre groups, Artists, Authors, etc. are shared between the children involved.

### **Clubs run by staff**

Usually there are no charges made for these. However if a club such as Silk Painting requires expensive materials parents are asked for a contribution toward the cost.
